SELECTION OF THE WHISKY

Our two master blenders John Petersen and Michael Henry have dipped and nosed the remaining casks of 1989 and 1990 in our warehouse.

From these they have selected 10 which they believe best represent the quality and style of whisky from the Littlemill Distillery.

These 10 casks have been married together to deliver this exceptional 25 year old lowland single malt whisky.

The 1989 liquid went into the cask on 17th December 1989 at 68.5 degrees and the 1990 was casked between 1st & 4th April 1990 at between 68.6 and 68.7 degrees.

FINISHING OF THE WHISKY

The liquid was originally laid down in a mixture of the finest American and European Oak casks and for this 1st bottling it has been married together and has experienced a period of finishing in 1st fill European Oloroso Sherry casks.

RARE AMONGST LOWLAND MALTS IN USING A HIGHLAND WATER SOURCE, AS WELL AS PEAT FROM STORNOWAY AND PERTSHIRE, LITTLEMILL IS KNOWN FOR A SUBTLY FLORAL, VANILLA-RICH SWEETNESS. A SIP OF THIS FINE WHISKY IS MORE THAN JUST A MEMORABLE PLEASURE. IT IS A UNIQUE AND HISTORIC EXPERIENCE.

THE HISTORY OF LITTLEMILL DISTILLERY

The Littlemill distillery was officially established in 1772 on the site of an old brewery that had been founded during the 14th century in Bowling on the banks of the River Clyde near Glasgow.

It is also rumoured that illicit distilling had taken place here since 1750 when the site was bought by George Buchan, a malt master, and according to the renowned whisky historian and writer Misako Udo in her book 'The Scotch Whisky Distilleries' distilling may have taken place here for many centuries before, possibly making it the world's oldest whisky distillery.

It is a tragedy that Littlemill fell into perpetual silence in 1994 and then the distillery was destroyed by fire in 2004. All that is left is the ghost of Littlemill and of course the last remaining drops of an outstanding single malt whisky. Once consumed an important part of Scotland's and Scotch whisky's heritage will be lost forever.

Specially bottled and packaged for whisky connoisseurs and collectors around the world, this limited release makes a very rare and special gift or can be opened and enjoyed when the occasion is special enough.



Made from locally grown peat kilned barley and blended with spring water from Auchentorlie burn, this whisky has the hallmark of a fine Lowland whisky – delicate, gentle, sweet and malty. Now overlaid with the finish of Oloroso sherry casks bringing a hint of creaminess and spice with a touch of sweetness.

For those who simply want to savour their investment and leave the bottle sealed, a sample of the whisky is included for a private tasting.
