

# Waffle Stitch Fingerless Gloves

**Gauge: 5 stitches/inch**

**Materials: 80-100 yards of worsted weight wool (gloves shown knit with about 80 yards of 100purewool.com Merino Worsted 3 ply)**

**Needle: US 7 (4.5 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge**



These fingerless gloves were designed to help me stashbust. I was able to knit a hat and these gloves with 1 skein of 100purewool (218 yards total).

These gloves are knit flat and seamed up the side. They knit up quickly, and really look more complicated than they are!

Waffle stitch worked back and forth, beginning with a RS row:

Rows 1 & 2: [K2, p2] to end.

Rows 3 & 4: K all sts.

Repeat these four rows for Waffle Stitch.

## **Pattern:**

Cast on 36 stitches

Work waffle stitch for 4 rows (1 complete repeat)

Work 10 rows of stockinette (knit one row, purl one row)

Work waffle stitch for 7 repeats

Work 4 rows of stockinette

Work waffle stitch for 4 rows (1 complete repeat)

Knit 2 rows

Bind off and seam up, leaving a thumb opening. Repeat for 2nd mitt!

Additional information: I didn't slip my edge stitches, but you can choose to slip the first stitch of each row in order to have a clean edge.
