



## SAINT-MAUR VETERANS EPEE

11 & 12 February 2017

*Summary of free translation of regulation and program of the 11-12 February 2017 competitions. The French version of the regulation will prevail on this free translation.*

### Categories

- V1: fencers born between 1 January 1968 and 31 December 1977
- V2: fencers born between 1 January 1958 and 31 December 1967 (cat. A FIE)
- V3: fencers born between 1 January 1948 and 31 December 1957 (cat. B FIE)
- V4: fencers born in 1947 and before (cat C FIE)

## Saturday 11 February 2017

### **National Circuit Veterans Men Epee (Individual)**

*As per regulation applicable to the Veterans Category (Règlement Sportif available on the website of the French Fencing Federation FFE)*

- Open to non FFE fencers
- Scratch at 11 :30 am
- One single round of poules: 8 fencers (preferably), 5 touches, 3 minutes, all categories mixed (V1, V2, V3, V4),
- Handicap (has changed since September 2016, as per French regulation - Règlement Sportif - Chapter 8 – Veterans Competition ), one negative touch of handicap by difference of two categories (V1 vs V3 – V1 starts with one negative touch -), and two for V1 vs V4 ( V1 starts with two negative touches ) with a maximum of 2
- Followed by direct elimination **SEPARATED BY CATEGORY**: 10 touches, 2 \* 3 minutes.

## Sunday 12 February 2017

### International Veterans Tournament by Teams

- Open to non FFE fencers (V 1 to V 4)
- Scratch at 8:30 am, teams composition to be provided no later than Saturday 5 pm
- Competition by clubs or “national teams” engaged by their federation or their representative (National Veterans Commission, for example if any). Non club teams are allowed to participate but not in A tableau
- The sum of the ages of the fencers in the course of a relay must always be at least equal to 150 years. The age of each fencer will be determined as follows: year of the competition – year of birth. For example 2017 – 1961 = 56 (for example with a competition in 2017 and a fencer born in 1961).
- Non Veterans Ladies can participate, they will be considered as man V1 for the handicap (see handicap for Men individual competition on Saturday), and aged 50 when computing the total age of 150 as required. Three Senior Ladies will then reach the total age of 150. As Senior ladies are considered as aged 50, 10 will be added to the age of Veteran ladies (a Veteran Lady aged 45 will be computed as 55). Ladies can participate in mixed teams or in only Ladies teams.
- Veterans ladies can participate in both individual and team competition ; non presentation FIE regulation will be strictly applied (T86)
- Formula by relay, 3 fencers plus one reserve
- A bout is composed of 3 relays of 5 touches, each relay is 3 minutes
- Negative handicap of 1 touch by difference of 2 categories, as per men individual competition on Saturday, plus one touch of difference for ladies (total negative handicap is limited to 2). The handicap is applied at the beginning of each relay, and announced by the referee  
Example: a team ends his first relay 5/2, his following team member (V1) meets with a V3, the score is reduced by one touch, the second relay therefore starts 4/2 and will end at 10 touches or 3 minutes
- One round of poules (6 teams, or 5), with ONE single bout of 3 relays. Composition of team is provided before each bout (change is possible during the round of poules)
- The 2 first CLUB or “national” teams of each poule are qualified , others are qualified as per their indice (V/M, then TD/TR)
- Direct elimination in Tableau A for qualified 32 club or “national” teams, 3 bouts of 3 relays (ends when a team wins 2 bouts). Numbering of fencers is provided at the beginning of the first bout and is fixed for the 3 bouts
- As the tournament is based on relays, non combativity regulation will be applied (T 87-6) in poules and tableau
- Club and “national” teams not qualified in Tableau A (over 32) and other teams will participate in Tableau B
- Regulation might be adapted depending on the number of teams concerned
- A daughter of a member of a team will be accepted in the team, whatever her club

## National Circuit Veterans Epee Ladies (Individual)

- Open to non FFE fencers
  - Scratch at 10 am
  - Two rounds above 30 participants : 5 touches, 3 minutes, all categories mixed (V1, V2, V3, V4),
  - Handicap (has changed since September 2016, as per French regulation - Règlement Sportif - Chapter 8 – Veterans Competition ), one negative touch of handicap by difference of two categories (V1 vs V3 – V1 starts with one negative touch -), and two for V1 vs V4 ( V1 starts with two negative touches ) with a maximum of 2
- Followed by direct elimination **SEPARATED BY CATEGORY**: 10 touches, 2 \* 3 minutes, with a minimum of 8 participants per category
