## HEREBY DECIDES AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Article 1</u>: A written competitive entrance examination for the admission of **540** student civil engineers into the 1<sup>st</sup> year of the 1<sup>st</sup> Cycle of the Higher Institute of the Sahel of the University of Maroua is hereby launched for the 2013/2014 academic year in the following fields of study:

3) The department of Climatology; Hydrology and Soil Sciences will take in student for training as technicians lasting 2 years.

## Article 2:

- (1) The competitive entrance examination is open in a single session to Cameroonians of both sexes, who are holders of the Baccalaureate certificate required in the field of study solicited or the G.C.E. A/L obtained in at least two subjects including the major subject of the series and the G.C.E. O/L obtained in a single session in at least four subjects including the major subject of the series; the subject titled "Religious Knowledge" shall not be taken into consideration.
- (2) The table below subsumes the nature of the civil engineering diploma/degree envisaged, the type of Baccalauréat and the major subject which the candidate should have passed at the G.C.E. A/L in order to be authorized to sit in for the competitive entrance examination:

<u>Article 3:</u> Foreign candidates proposed for the written competitive entrance examination by their embassies may be admitted by way of file study within the limits of available places.

Article 4: Application files shall comprise all the following documents:

- A registration form available at the Office of the Director of the Advanced Institute of the Sahel of the University of Maroua, in regional delegations of secondary education and on the MINESUP website: <u>http://www.minesup.gov.cm</u>. or that of the University of Maroua: http://www.unimaroua.citi.cm;
- A certified true copy of the birth certificate, dated not more than three (3) months ago;
- Transcripts of Probatoire certificate or GCE O/L, the Baccalauréat or GCE A/L signed or certified as true copies by the competent authorities;
- A certified true copy of the Baccalauréat or GCE A/L, or any other recognized diploma by the Minister of Higher Education, issued not more than three (3) months ago, or a result Testimonial signed or certified by the competent authorities;
- A medical certificate issued by a medical officer of the Administration and testifying that the candidate is fit to undergo higher education studies;
- A certificate of non conviction (bulletin N° 3) issued not more than three (3) months ago;
- A bank receipt of the payment of the sum of fifteen thousand (15 000) CFA Francs representing the examination fee issued by BICEC, Account N° **38176472001-24**. N° other mode of payment shall be accepted;
- A self-addressed envelope of the A3 format bearing a 400 CFA francs stamp;
- Four (4) passport-sized (4 x 4) photographs;

<u>Article 5</u>: Candidates with foreign diplomas should present either the equivalence order or the receipt of submission of the application for equivalence issued by the Minister of Higher Education. In any case, their final admission can be announced only after the presentation within the prescribed deadline by the competent authority of the instrument granting the required equivalence.

<u>Article 6</u>: All complete files should be submitted either in the regional delegations of secondary education or the Office of the Director of the Advanced Institute of the Sahel of the University of Maroua latest on 09 August 2013 at 3.30 p.m. prompt.

Article 7: The written competitive entrance examination shall comprise:

- Three written papers accounting for 70%
- A mark based on academic performance accounting for 30%

Article 8: The written examinations shall take place on 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> July 2013 in the following centres: Buea, Kousseri, Douala, Dschang, Maroua, Ngaoundere and Yaounde.

(2) The syllabuses for the competitive entrance examination shall be that of the Baccalauréat or GCE A/L for each speciality. Each written examination paper shall be graded from zero (0) to twenty (20) and shall have the above-mentioned coefficients.

(3) After the written examination and after the inclusion of academic performance marks, the jury shall draw up and publish the list of successful candidates per series. In no case whatsoever shall an admission be deferred from one year to another.

<u>Article 10</u>: The mark for the candidates' academic performance shall be awarded taking into account the following:

- The candidate's age;
- The number of years spent in Secondary Education;
- Marks or grades obtained at the Probatoire certificate examination or O/L and at the Baccalauréat or GCE A/L.

<u>Article 11</u>: The composition of the jury shall be made known by a special instrument of the Minister of Higher Education.

Article 12: The examination fees shall be non-refundable.

<u>Article 13</u>: The Rector of the University of Maroua and the Director of University Accreditations and Quality are responsible, each in his own sphere, for the implementation of this decision which shall be registered and published in English and French wherever necessary.
