

### Little Charmers - Redwork Individuals

Redwork is very simple. It requires just one color of thread to sew out the entire design. The first redwork was actually done with red thread on a white background in the 1800's. Today, you can choose any color you like for your embroidery.

Since these designs are so "light" in terms of density, they require only a single layer of stabilizer. We use one layer of tear away stabilizer hooped with the fabric.

Where a design has more than one color stop, this is to prevent jump threads from getting tangled up in the sewout. When your machine stops, just start again with the same color. There will be some jump threads on the design but we planned these very carefully so that none get trapped and they will be very easy to trim.

If you decide to use these on fleece, we would recommend placing one layer of a rinse away (wash away) stabilizer on top to prevent the threads from sinking down into the fleece.

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
