

Free Halloween Teddie (2 sizes)

4x4 hoop

65.0x99.3 mm (2.56x3.91 ")

4177 stitches


6 colors, 9 thread changes

5x7 hoop

105.0x160.2 mm (4.13x6.31 ")

8128 stitches

6 colors, 9 thread changes



- Color 1 outline stitch to show you where the mylar will go. After this sews, lay a piece of mylar on top of the hoop to cover this outline. You can use a couple of pieces of tape to hold this in place.
- Color 2 tack down stitch for the mylar (can be the same as #1) - do not trim excess mylar until all colors have been sewn
- Color 3 Teddy Bear face, hands and feet
- Color 4 White part of the candy corn
- Color 5 Yellow part of the candy corn
- Color 6 Orange part of the candy corn
- Color 7 Mouth area of the teddy bear
- Color 8 Eyes, Nose and Outline

Tip: We use color #3 for the first three color stops - the outline and tack down stitches are hidden so this can save you time and thread changes.

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
