



TEA CUP COASTER INSTRUCTIONS



4X4 HOOP
93 x 98 mm's

5X7 HOOP
12.8 X 13.5 mm's



MATERIALS

- Water Soluble Stabiliser to fit hoop
- 5x5 (6x8) piece of:
 - Thin Pellon/Batting
 - Front Fabric
 - Backing Fabric
- Small tea colored fabric for top of cup
- Sharp scissors

Matching Bobbin thread



PREPARATION – COASTER



**Optional


I have been using a very thin iron-on Interfacing on the Coaster backing fabric – it just makes the fabric easier to cut on the back of the hoop, and no threads peeking out of the satin stitch.

CONSTRUCTION

- Load design to machine
- Hoop 2 layers of Water Soluble Stabiliser
- Thread machine with a neutral color (we used Blue throughout)



Stitch Color 1 – the outline of the Cup



Place your pellaon/thin
batting over the
Guideline



Stitch Color 2 to attach



Place tea fabric over
Guideline

Stitch Color 3 to attach

**Skip this color if you
want to leave the
Coaster one color



Trim away excess
fabric as pictured



Change thread to the color you would like for quilting

Stitch Color 4 – Tea Quilting



Change thread to the color you would like for quilting on the Cup

Stitch Color 5 – Cup Quilting

**Skip these colors if you do not want the quilting and/or wording



Change thread to the color you would like for wording on the Cup

Stitch Color 6 – Tea



Remove hoop from Machine

Tape Backing Fabric in place as pictured

WRONG-SIDE OF FABRIC FACING HOOP




Return hoop to
Machine

Stitch Color 7 to
attach backing
AND stitches
handle detail



Remove hoop
from Machine

Cut away excess
Fabric on FRONT
and back of hoop



Return hoop to
Machine

Change bobbin
thread to match
Satin Stitch

Stitch Color 8
which zig zags,
then stitches satin
stitch edge



Remove from hoop

Cut away the
excess Stabiliser
around the edges

Use a Cotton
Bud/Q Tip and
warm water to
dissolve any
stabiliser left on the
edges
