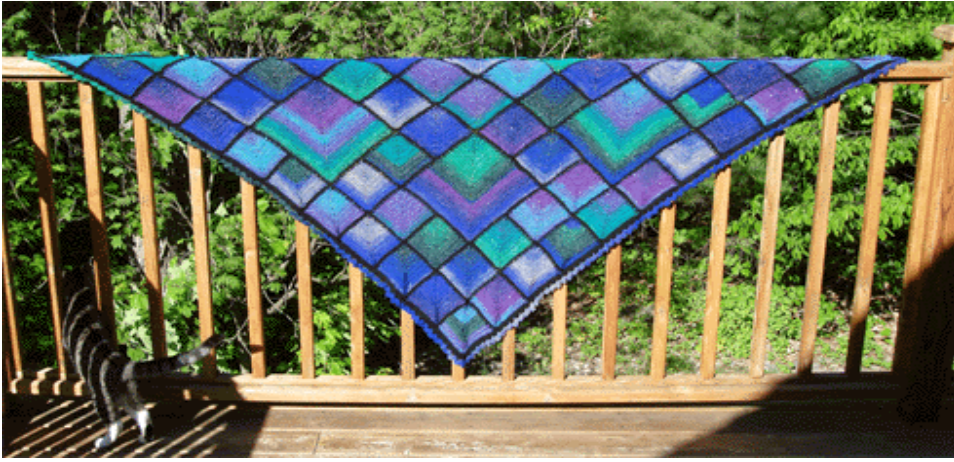


Crochet Mitered Square Shawl

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Formatted for Letter (8.5" x 11") paper



This pattern is the basic recipe for the shawl.

Squares are worked so that the first 2 rows are done in black, and the remainder of the square is done in the the coloured yarn.

The first square worked is the one at the bottom point of the shawl. From there you work upward toward the top/edges.

You can choose whether or not to add the larger squares. If you omit the larger squares, you can easily make a smaller shawl by making fewer rows of squares.

The top row uses triangles to fill in the spaces between the squares.

A plain black border is worked around the entire shawl, then a frilly coloured border is added.



Photos show the triangles in the top row, and the border detail.

Materials

4 balls Noro Silk Garden Sock (1312 yards)

0.8 ball Austermann Step (337 yards)

5.5 mm hook

Mitered Decrease Square (first square, bottom of shawl)

Base Ch 36
Row 1 Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc along each stitch in the row (35 sc), ch 1 turn
Row 2 16 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch, 16 sc (33 sc), ch 1 turn
Row 3 15 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch, 15 sc (31 sc), ch 1 turn
Row 4 14 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch, 14 sc (29 sc), ch 1 turn
Row 5 13 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch, 13 sc (27 sc), ch 1 turn
Row 6 12 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch, 12 sc (25 sc), ch 1 turn
Row 7 11 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch, 11 sc (23 sc), ch 1 turn
Row 8 10 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch, 10 sc (21 sc), ch 1 turn
Row 9 9 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch, 9 sc (19 sc), ch 1 turn
Row 10 8 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch, 8 sc (17 sc), ch 1 turn
Row 11 7 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch, 7 sc (15 sc), ch 1 turn
Row 12 6 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch, 6 sc (13 sc), ch 1 turn
Row 13 5 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch, 5 sc (11 sc), ch 1 turn
Row 14 4 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch, 4 sc (9 sc), ch 1 turn
Row 15 3 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch, 3 sc (7 sc), ch 1 turn
Row 16 2 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch, 2 sc (5 sc), ch 1 turn
Row 17 1 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch, 1 sc (3 sc), ch 1 turn
Draw yarn up through all 3 stitches, yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on
Row 18 hook - sc3tog made. Fasten off

Next square (when hanging off only 1 square)

Base Join yarn with sl st to last stitch of last square, ch 1
Base Work 18 sc evenly along side of square, ch 18 (36 ch)
Rows Follow rows 1 - 18 of first square for remaining directions

Next square (when going between 2 squares)

Base Join yarn with sl st to last stitch of last square, ch 1
Work 18 sc evenly along side of square, and 17 sc up side of second square
Base (35 sc), ch 1 turn
Row 1 Work sc in each stitch along the row (35 sc), ch 1 turn
Rows Follow rows 2 - 18 of first square for remaining directions

Double size square (when going between 2 squares)

- Base Join yarn with sl st to last stitch of last square, ch 1
Work 36 sc evenly along the side of 2 squares, and 35 sc up side of second square (71 ch), ch 1 turn
- Base
- Row 1 Work sc in each stitch in the row (71 sc), ch 1 turn
- Row 2 34 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch 34 sc (69 sc), ch 1 turn
- Row 3 33 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch 33 sc (67 sc), ch 1 turn
- Row 4 32 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch 32 sc (65 sc), ch 1 turn
- Row 5 31 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch 31 sc (63 sc), ch 1 turn
- Row 6 30 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch 30 sc (61 sc), ch 1 turn
- Row 7 29 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch 29 sc (59 sc), ch 1 turn
- Row 8 28 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch 28 sc (57 sc), ch 1 turn
- Row 9 27 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch 27 sc (55 sc), ch 1 turn
- Row 10 26 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch 26 sc (53 sc), ch 1 turn
- Row 11 25 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch 25 sc (51 sc), ch 1 turn
- Row 12 24 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch 24 sc (49 sc), ch 1 turn
- Row 13 23 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch 23 sc (47 sc), ch 1 turn
- Row 14 22 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch 22 sc (45 sc), ch 1 turn
- Row 15 21 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch 21 sc (43 sc), ch 1 turn
- Row 16 20 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch 20 sc (41 sc), ch 1 turn
- Row 17 19 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch 19 sc (39 sc), ch 1 turn
- Row 18 18 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch 18 sc (37 sc), ch 1 turn
- Row 19 17 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch 17 sc (35 sc), ch 1 turn
- Rows Follow rows 1 - 18 of first square for remaining directions

Triangles (1/2 square) for top row (when hanging off only 1 square)

- Base Join yarn with sl st to last stitch of last square, ch 1
- Base Work 18 sc evenly along side of square, ch 18 (36 ch)
Dec sc in 2nd and 3rd chains from hook, sc along each stitch, dec sc in last 2 stitches (33 sc), ch 1 turn
- Row 1 Dec Sc in first 2 stitches, 13 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch, 13 sc, dec sc in last 2 stitches (29 sc), ch 1 turn
- Row 2 Dec Sc in first 2 stitches, 11 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch, 11 sc, dec sc in last 2 stitches (25 sc), ch 1 turn
- Row 3 Dec Sc in first 2 stitches, 9 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch, 9 sc, dec sc in last 2 stitches (21 sc), ch 1 turn
- Row 4 Dec Sc in first 2 stitches, 7 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch, 7 sc, dec sc in last 2 stitches (17 sc), ch 1 turn
- Row 5 Dec Sc in first 2 stitches, 5 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch, 5 sc, dec sc in last 2 stitches (13 sc), ch 1 turn
- Row 6 Dec Sc in first 2 stitches, 3 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch, 3 sc, dec sc in last 2 stitches (9 sc), ch 1 turn
- Row 7 Dec Sc in first 2 stitches, 1 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch, 1 sc, dec sc in last 2 stitches (5 sc), ch 1 turn
- Row 8 Draw yarn up through all 3 stitches, yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on hook - sc3tog made. Fasten off
- Row 9

Triangles (1/2 square) for top row (when hanging off 2 squares)

- Base Join yarn with sl st to last stitch of last square, ch 1
Work 18 sc evenly along side of square, and 17 sc up side of second square
- Base (35 sc), ch 1 turn
Dec sc in first 2 stitches, sc along each stitch, dec sc in last 2 stitches (33 sc),
ch 1 turn
- Row 1 Dec Sc in first 2 stitches, 13 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch, 13 sc, dec sc in
last 2 stitches (29 sc), ch 1 turn
- Row 2 Dec Sc in first 2 stitches, 11 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch, 11 sc, dec sc in
last 2 stitches (25 sc), ch 1 turn
- Row 3 Dec Sc in first 2 stitches, 9 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch, 9 sc, dec sc in last
2 stitches (21 sc), ch 1 turn
- Row 4 Dec Sc in first 2 stitches, 7 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch, 7 sc, dec sc in last
2 stitches (17 sc), ch 1 turn
- Row 5 Dec Sc in first 2 stitches, 5 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch, 5 sc, dec sc in last
2 stitches (13 sc), ch 1 turn
- Row 6 Dec Sc in first 2 stitches, 3 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch, 3 sc, dec sc in last
2 stitches (9 sc), ch 1 turn
- Row 7 Dec Sc in first 2 stitches, 1 sc, skip 1 stitch, sc, skip 1 stitch, 1 sc, dec sc in last
2 stitches (5 sc), ch 1 turn
- Row 8 Draw yarn up through all 3 stitches, yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on
hook - sc3tog made. Fasten off
- Row 9

Border (black)

- Did 2 rows of Sc along the top of the shawl in black. This made the border the
same width as the borders at the bottom of each mitered square.
- Row 1 Did 2 rows of Sc around the entire shawl. In the corners I did SC, ch 1 (or 2),
SC in the same space. Note: When working corners ensure work is laying flat
and not puckering.
- Row 2 and 3

Border (coloured)

- Slip stitch to start, then * Ch 3, skip 2 stitches, 1 Dc in next stitch, 2 Ch, 4 Hdc
around stem of Dc just worked, repeat from * to end. Last stitch, the Dc is in
the same space as the first Ch 3, and you do 3 Hdc around the stem of the DC,
then slip stitch to the first Ch 3.
- Row 1
