12. Prizes	Prizes will be awarded in the 1^{st} and the 2^{nd} division to the best gross score and the best net score per day in each division.			

A "Longest Drive" and "Nearest the pin" will be organised on both courses.

The overall winners at the end of the 2 rounds will be the best gross score in the 1st and 2nd division and the best net score of each division.

No one may take more than one prize, except with drawn and contests.
