ss France Farewell Voyages

Proudly, and in the same grand and glorious style for which she has been famous for more than a decade, the Liner FRANCE will make two final voyages in October 1974, before being retired from service. These voyages will be operated on a first class basis.

Bidding adieu to Canada and the United States, the largest passenger liner in the world — a sparkling symbol of French graces — will sail from France October 11 and cruise the Gulf of St. Lawrence before arriving in New York on the 17th. After a full day and evening of fond farewell greetings, she will be off again on the 18th for her last 7-day voyage, through the Azores and home.

In keeping with the truly historic nature of the voyage, the ship will be saluted in New York harbor upon departure. On board during both of the farewell voyages will be special entertainment and treats.

You will want to be among those passengers who share an undeniable urge to "be there" and take part in what amounts to the closing of an era.

VOYAGE "A" (6 days — October 11 to 17)

The first farewell voyage of the SS France begins at Le Havre on October 11. After a brief call at Southampton from 6:00 to 9:00 p.m. that day, you'll sail across the Atlantic to Canada. Cruising between the Strait of Belle Isle and Halifax on the 15th, two days of sheer enjoyment lay ahead with nautical sightseeing along the coast of Labrador, Quebec and Newfoundland in the Gulf of St. Lawrence. Arrival in New York is set for 8:00 a.m. on the 17th — time enough for a full day and evening of fond farewells in port.

VOYAGE "B" (7 days — October 18 to 25)

This is it! Final departure is at noon, October 18, with a farewell salute in New York harbor. Weather permitting, there will be a short call between 8:00 and 2:00 a.m. on the 22nd among the lovely Azores. You'll have ample time to reflect and reminisce if you've sailed the France before. If not, just relax and enjoy the least hurried most wonderful way to cross the ocean. Many will await your historic arrival on October 25 in Cannes.
