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## **TRANSNATIONAL PROJECT MEETING** at Heathfield School, England from April 20<sup>th</sup> to April 26<sup>th</sup> 2015.

This transnational meeting took place at the same time as the short-term exchange of pupils at Heathfield School, England from April 20<sup>th</sup> to April 26<sup>th</sup> 2015.

# The subjects discussed by the people mentioned above during this transnational meeting are mentioned below :

Apart from judging the poetry competition and doing a report of all the activities done during **Part 1: My House, My Culture**, we mainly talked about the activities we planned for **Part 2 : Houses of the Past**.

First, we said that when exchanging about the project, we would only exchange between the 5 of us (that is to say the 5 coordinators in each country : Emma for the UK, Sadik Sedat for Turkey, Christina for Greece, Maria José for Spain and me for France) and then each coordinator would inform the teachers in her or his school.

We agreed on 4 activities (the last one being optional) to be done by all schools and to be published on the blog : these activities were taken from what Serpil from Turkey had prepared when we were gathering ideas to fill in the application form last year.

#### Activity N°1 : to be done by June 12th 2015.

Each country will prepare a dictionary including proverbs, literary expressions and quotations about "home". The dictionary will be in English and in their mother tongue. (For example one of the famous sayings of Atatürk : "Peace at home, peace in the world.", or a well-known sentence like "There is no place like home.")

Activity  $N^{\circ}2$ : to be done before the visit to Turkey, that is to say by October 5th 2015. Pupils (in pairs, or groups) will choose the oldest house (or the one that seem the most traditional) in their neighbourhood ( in their street, or in their village) then they will first visualise it (**photo or drawing**) and will make an **interview** with the people living there in English. They will prepare a **newspaper page** using their visual and interview.

This will be **our competition** for part 2. (Maria will give us the criteria as they have already worked on newspaper articles). The format of the page will be **A3**. We can also invite a journalist in our schools so that he/she explains about his/her job (Employability).

### Activity N°3 : to be done by Christmas 2015.

Each school will organise a visit to an old place (of Celtic origin, of Roman origin, of medieval origin...etc) to work on the houses of the time and a film will be made from this visit and the activities done in that place or about that place.

#### Activity N°4 :(Optional) No date was given.

The pupils in groups will choose a different region from their own (but in their country) which is famous with its typical traditional houses and make a model or a computer model of the houses. SketchUp can be used. Silvia will give help if it is needed.

#### **Visit to Turkey : 5 days** in Kandira **from Monday October 5th till Friday October 9th**. Travelling will take place on Oct 4th and October 10th.

We mentioned doing a **virtual lesson** with FlashMeeting or another platform : John said he would look more closely at it to see if something was possible in this part or in Part 3.

As far as the **Twinspace** is concerned, I managed to show how to register our students on it so that we could organise little forums where students would write their opinion about different questions. We said it would be an activity we could do just before the summer holidays for instance or at a moment when we are less busy.

Finally, we checked the dates for the **visit to Greece** with Katia and John, as Maria José and the Spanish students will not take part in the visit to Turkey. So the visit to Greece is planned **from April 18th till April 24th 2016**.
