The migrants crisis

Thousands of migrants are dying every month while trying to enter Europe. Why are they fleeing and risking their lives?

It is estimated that

- In 2015: more than 1 million migrants came in Europe.
- In 2016: 350,000 refugees have desperately packed onto overcrowded vessels to Italy after fleeing war-torn countries such as Iraq, Syria and Libya. Now, migrants are increasingly using road and rail transport to access the EU.
- Since the early 2017 : more than 25 000 refugees

Your work:

<u>Explain the migrants crisis</u>: Why do the migrants flee their country? What way do they chose? Why is their trip so dangerous? How are their hosting conditions? What is their status?

Make a presentation of the situation. The form is unrestricted. For example, you can describe the testimony of a migrant, or a volunteer worker for the rescue of refugees, or a politician who wants to defend the hosting (or the opposite situation...),
