On Thursday we recorded a film about childrens' rights. We spoke about breaking rights in our countries, institutions we can address in case our rights are broken.



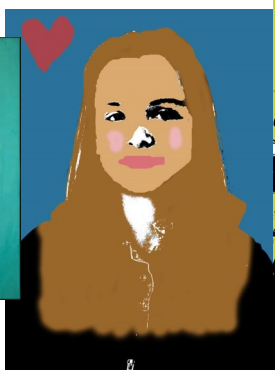
After recording a film we went to the day care home for the disabled and there we were shown around the centre and after that helped them in making Easter decorations.
