5. Uphold National Sovereignty and sovereign rights
6. Exercise National Authority in Specified Areas
7. Participate in international crisis management and peace support missions
8. Contribute to international cooperation in the area of defence and security
9. Contribute to safeguarding Norwegian public safety and social security

### 3: Stavanger, Haugesund, Bergen, Kristiansund;

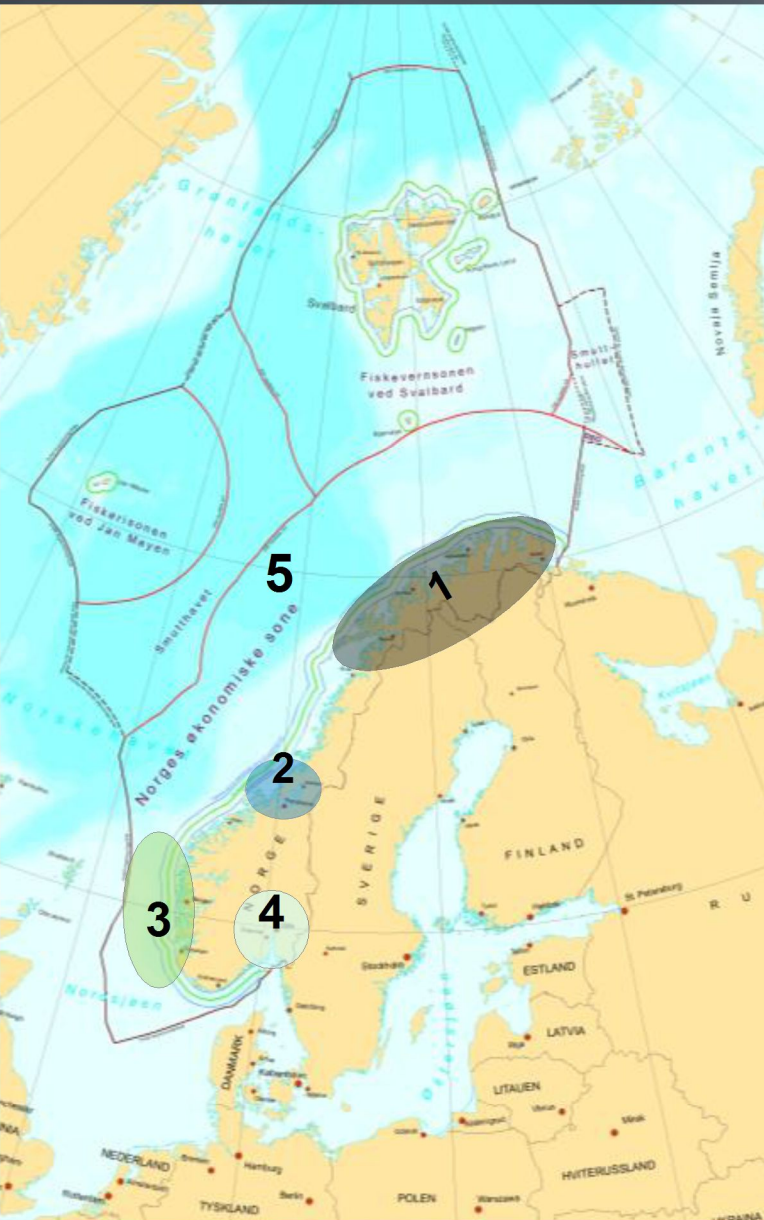

### 5: Norwegian waters and jurisdiction;

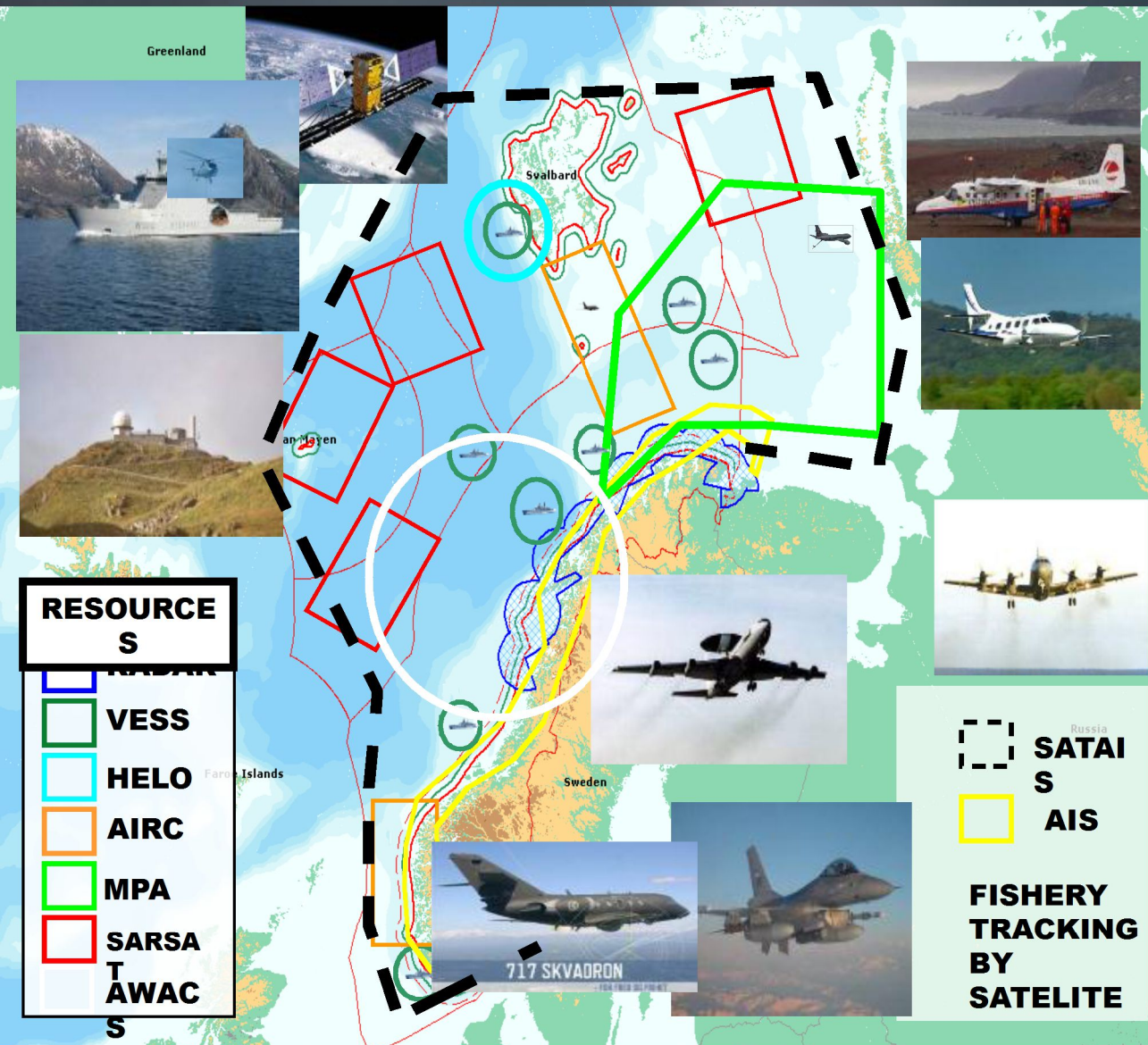
