




To play loudly (f), a wider distance between upper and lower teeth is maintained while the air jet is aimed slightly downward. Observe the position of the lower teeth.



To play softly (p) the distance between upper and lower teeth is narrowed while the air jet is aimed forward. Observe the position of the lower teeth.


