Cadillac, walled town of the 13th century

Discover the medieval walled town of Cadillac, built in 1280 for the King of England. Located on the banks of the Garonne, the city has an exceptional architectural heritage: grid plan streets, arcaded houses where many shops are located.



Château of the Dukes of Epernon

This typical ceremonial palace still retains its original 17th century decorations: marble fireplaces, tapestries, painted coffered ceilings. In the 19th century, the château became a jail for women. A french garden is located behind the château.

At the end of the visit, enjoy some labeled wines from the vineyards of Cadillac. Let's sip red wine and sweet white wine, eating some macaroons of Chef **Sabrina Gommée**, the mixture is as surprising as divine !
