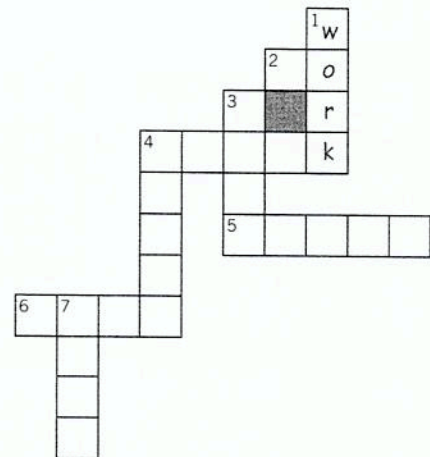

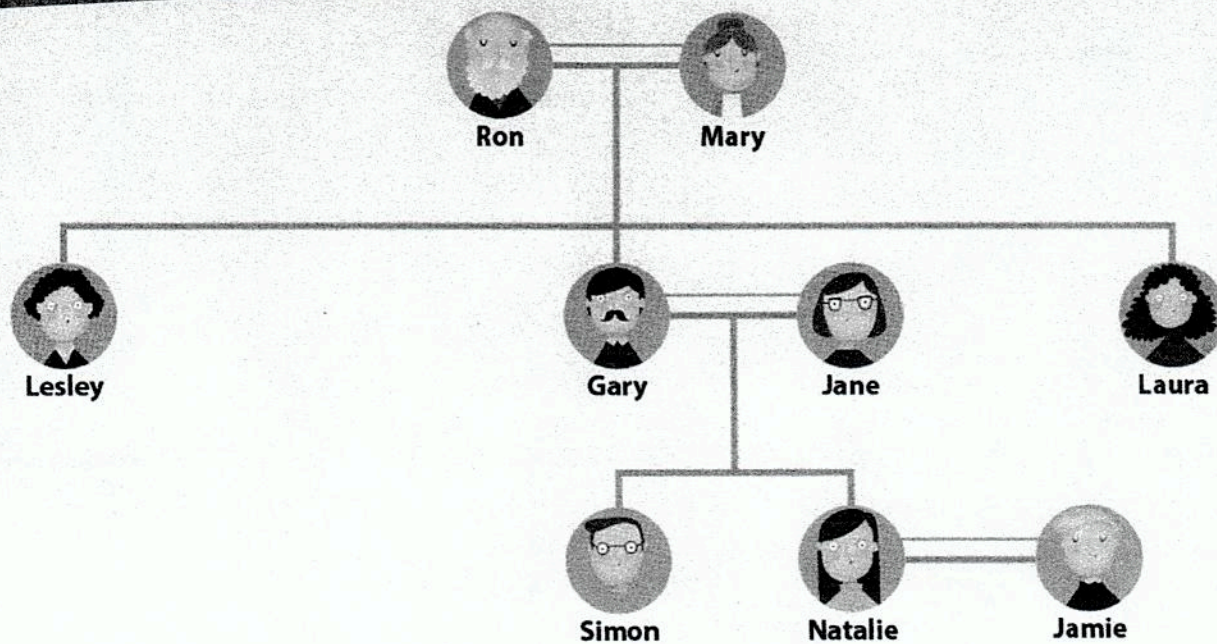

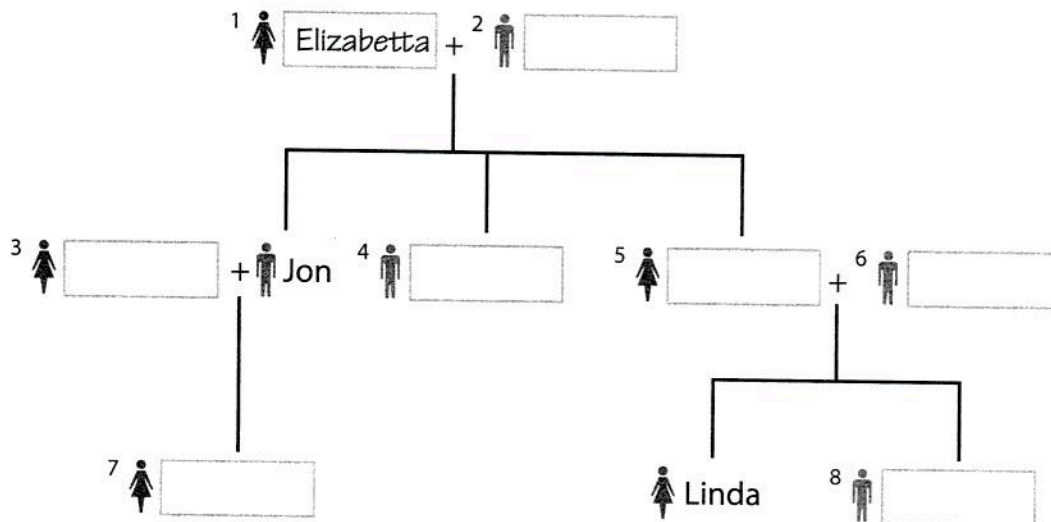
Thanks for your email. I love the photos of your family. You have a big family! My family is small. Here's a new photo of us on holiday.

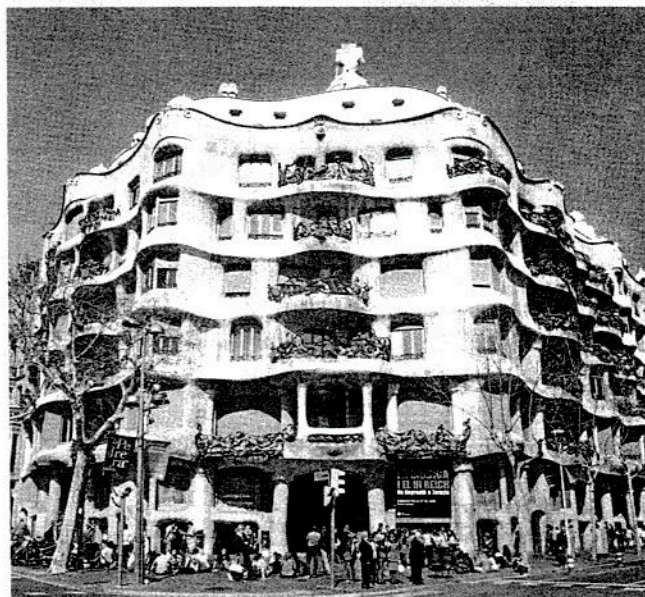
