Frs John Larsen and Ben McKenna are making their annual retreat this week and Fr Juan Carlos Pina is on vacation.

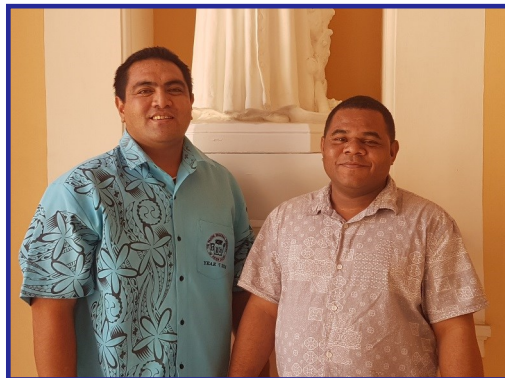
Fr John Harhager has returned from his visit to Fiji and the USA.

MARIST SCHOOL IN DAKAR EXPANDS

The Marist school at Ndiakhirate in the periphery of Dakar, Senegal has been open for two school years now. To be able to respond to the high demand of new students, and to improve the stability of the



school project, construction of a new block began a few weeks ago. The picture above shows the project. The block will have nine classrooms, a computer room (IT), a little library and some office rooms for teachers and the administration of the school. The building will be completed by the first week of October and will be ready for the new school year 2019-2020.
