Very simple shawl





Materials

Size 8 (5 mm) needles or one size 8 cicular needle if you want a very big shawl

The amount of wool depends on the size of the shawl:

- For a shawl like the blue one, you'll need 325 g of wool (50% acrylic, 30% new wool, 20% polyamid needles n°5)
- For a shawl like the black one you'll need 350 g de wool (100% acrylic needles n°5)

Dimensions

Black shawl: 210 cm * 90 cm

Blue shawl: 145 cm * 70 cm

Skills

This shawl can be knitted by beginners. You just have to know how to increase and how to knit in garter stitch.

Tips and Tricks

For a small shawl, 40 cm needles will be long enough. For a bigger shawl, you'll need bigger needles. I knitted 2 of my big shawls with 60 cm needles: they're really really long, not pratical at all... it was just because I didn't know the existence of circular needles...

To ease your work, if your circular needles do as mine do: twist in all directions, you can start your shawl with straight needles the switch to circular needles when the shawl becomes to big for the 40 cm needles. You'll just have to go on in flat knitting.

Knitting

Cast on 3 stitches

Knit 2 rows in garter stitch

On every odd row, increase 1 stitch on both sides

Knit in garter stitch until you reach wanted size

Bind off loosely

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
