Fabric A • 4-3" squares

- 8- 3" x 5 1/2"
- 4- 1 1/2" x 3"

Fabric B • 16- 3" squares

• 1-6 1/4" x 12 1/2" strip


Fabric C • 1-6 1/4" x 12 1/2" strip

Fabric E • 4- 1 1/2" x 5 1/2"

Fabric F • 4- 2" squares • 1- 1 1/2" square


Piecing-

Create Flying Geese units using fabrics A and B



Create HST using fabrics C & B


Refer to Perfect HST worksheet if needed




RST

Place fabrics C & B with right sides together (RST)

Mark squares/diagonal lines as shown. Stitch 1/4" away from marked diagonal lines as shown. Cut apart on marked lines.




Square to 5 1/2" Make 4




Sew Square using Fabric F to B corners

Square up HST to 5 1/2". With right sides together, place fabric F in fabric B corner. Mark a diagonal line as sewn. Sew.




Trim/Press




Make 4 units

Trim away fabric B 1/4" beyond the stitch line as shown. Press towards fabric B.










Pay close attention to the direction of the HST units when adding FG units. You will need to make 2 of each referring to the picture as needed.








Make 1 unit
