"Rudolph and Friends"

Banner finished size: approximately 5" x 44"

Please read through all directions before beginning.

From light brown wool cut:

- (9) heads with ears
- (9) heads without ears

Pin the head patterns to the wool and cut out on the line. Cut little slits beside the inside of the ears as indicated on pattern.

With right sides together, pair each of the heads with ears to the heads without ears.

Starting at the outside edge of one ear, sew around head, ending at the outside edge of the other ear. Leave open at the top.

Turn right side out through opening.

Lightly stuff head with polyfil.

Hot glue ends of twigs into opening.

Hand-stitch opening closed.

Add embellishments:

- Stitch little black beads for eyes onto heads.
- Hot glue pom-poms for noses onto heads.

Pin heads to ribbon or homespun, spacing evenly with Rudolph in the center, leaving several inches at each end.

Hand-stitch heads in place.

Tie ends of ribbon around nail or wherever you want to hang it.

What You Need

- ♥ 13" x 30" light brown wool
- ♥ Polyfil
- ♥ Hot glue gun
- ♥ Small twigs
- ♥ 18 little black beads
- ♥ 8 small black pom-poms
- ♥ 1 small red pom-pom
- ♥ 44" length of ribbon or homespun
