# Scrap Bucket Basket

Not sure what to do with small scraps of fabric or better yet how to store them? This scrap bucket pattern is the perfect plan! After you have created your fabric from smaller scraps, turn them into this bucket for storage!



#### **Materials**

1/2 yard of main fabric1/2 yard of heavy weight fusible1 yard rope

1/2 yard of lining fabric4 Extra Large Eyelets

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This project should be made from your own scrap fabric. You can find the complete **tutorial here**.

If you would like to create a quilted outlook, it is important to include an extra layer of fusible. This added component will add body and rigidly to the finished project.

Bucket basket can also be made from denim and duck cloth.

#### **Tools Needed:**

- Sewing machine
- Iron/Ironing board
- Basic sewing tools
- Hammer
- Tape

\*Option: A pocket can be added to the inside or front of bucket for additional storage.

<sup>\*</sup> Hammer is needed for eyelets and tape will be used to piece together the pattern.

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



Match double lines at center




Match double lines at center




Match double lines at center
