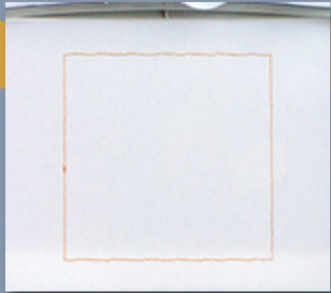


APPLIQUE INSTRUCTIONS #1

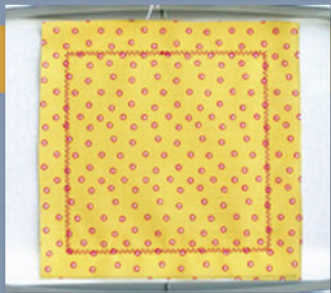
Always remember not to resize applique designs, Applique designs do not resize correctly. First, hoop your fabric with stabilizer as you would for any other embroidery design, then run your machine. The design will run a guideline of applique area as show below. Thread color is not important for guidelines (to tying the applique fabric down) generally a light or neutral color is use.

-Guideline of first applique area

-Next, lay ironed fabric flat over the guidelines area. You can use your hands to hold the fabric in place. Run the machine.

-When the guidelines have been stitch over the applique material, remove the hoop from the machine,

DO NOT UNHOOP THE FABRIC.

-When the guidelines have been stitched, trim the excess applique fabric, try to cut as close as possible, be carefull not to cut the thread that hold down the applique fabric.

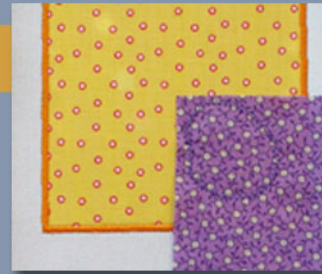


-Put the hoop back in the machine, start the machine again to stitch the tack and cover stitch. The cover stitch is the border around the applique shape.

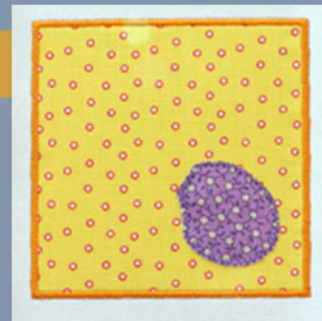


-Keep running the machine, and will lay down a new guideline for the next applique material (as shown)

DO NOT UNHOOP THE FABRIC.

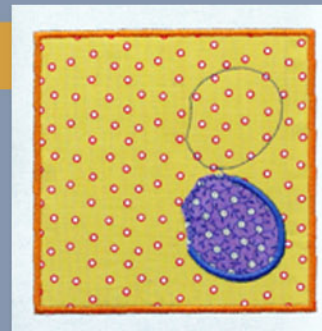

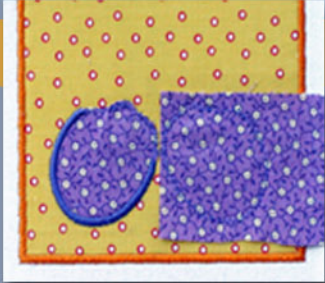

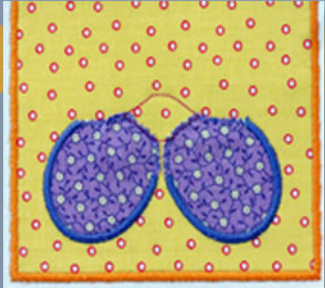
