These designs were stitched using DMC stranded cotton on 28-count evenweave over two threads of the fabric



### Make your own heart-shaped aperture

Checking for size against stitching, create a template by drawing half a heart on folded paper, then cut out and unfold for full shape. Draw around template on inside of card front, then cut out with a craft knife.
