Track Details

The BMX Olympic Arena Verona facility features a SX combo track incorporating both an 8mt SX start hill for Championship classes and 5mt start hill for Challenge classes.

The SX track is approximately 420mt long, while the regular track is approximately 340mt.

All riders must enter through their National Federation or by the BMX Team registered with the UCI of which they are a member; no individual entries will be accepted. Only Junior, U23 and Elite riders can participate at the UCI BMX Supercross World Cup. Registration deadlines are indicated in the General Race Parameters.

Entry payments

The entry fee for the 2021 UCI BMX Supercross World Cup is: Elite Men and Elite Women € 250 for online registration, new Under 23 Men and Under 23 Women class is € 150. After the registration deadline the National Federation will receive an invoice by e-mail, sent by Team BMX Verona. It is preferable to prepay the invoice, payment can be paid on site with cash (euros) or by bank transfer to:

Late registrations

Late registration is only possible through the National Federation or UCI BMX Team and until the riders' confirmation on site which is on Thursday 6th May between 17.30 - 19.30. The entry fee for late registration is € 500 for Elite men and Elite Women and € 300 for Under 23 Men and Under 23 Women and must be paid immediately on site. Late entries are entries handled after the online registration deadline and before the riders' confirmation deadline. Once passed the riders' confirmation deadline no more late entries will be accepted.

Under 23, the new category in the 2021 World Cup program

From 2021, the UCI is excited to announce the introduction of a new category to the UCI BMX Supercross series, the Under 23 category, offered for both Men and Women.

The UCI, in consultation with the BMX Commission has introduced the Under 23 category on a trial basis for 2021 with a view to fully integrate the categories from 2022 to the series.

The new category provides an opportunity for riders to join the series and enjoy an introduction to the UCI BMX Supercross World Cup series, without immediately racing against the Elite riders of the sport. The racing format for the category will be the same as the Elite categories, with riders starting with the First Round, Last Chance qualifier, then moving into the qualifiers and the final.

By offering the category, there will be more opportunity for the riders to reach the final, more opportunities for podium positions and more opportunities to win prize money.

For the 2021 series, riders can elect to enter either the Elite or Under 23 category, it is not mandatory to enter the Under 23 category and riders may choose to register for either category at each leg of the series. There is no requirement to remain in the Under 23 or the Elite category for the whole season.

World Cup standings will be calculated for the Under 23 category, however no UCI Ranking points will be available for the 2021 series.

UCI BMX WORLD CUP STANDINGS

A further development for 2021 is that the UCI BMX Supercross World Cup standing will be published for the first time on the UCI Website. This will allow all riders and teams to view their standings in one place.

Team BIBS

Team BIBs will be provided for National Teams and UCI BMX Teams (1 or 2 per nation, depending on the number of entries from that team) by the Secretary during the riders confirmation. This takes place during riders' confirmation on Thursday 6th May between 17.30 and 19.30 at the registration site. Teams will be asked to pay a € 100 deposit.

The team BIBs give access to allocated places explained by the PCP before the start of the first practice. The bibs need to be returned to the Secretary at latest by the end of racing on Sunday 9th May. You will also get the deposit back at that time.

Team areas

The team tent areas are situated behind the start hills. Team tent Areas are not accessible for cars. They need to be parked car parking national teams as shown on map.

Parking

Parking for teams and riders is possible in the car parking national teams. This parking is clearly indicated, and the car must be provided with a parking card. You will receive the parking card at the riders conformation.

Team managers meeting

The Team Management information will be shared by email to the Team Managers that have provided details when registering the riders through the UCI Registration system. There will be a question process from the notes.

It is strongly recommended that Team Managers provide their cell phone number and email so that communications can be made.





Team area tents

All teams can have a $3m \times 6m$ tent at their disposal in the team area. A table, chairs and powerpoint are included.

A tent in the team area can be rented by teams for € 450,-. Also it is possible to rent more than one tent; they will be connected to create one large space.

PLEASE NOTE: At the Team Area 1, located behind the start hills, there is room for 20 team tents. If the number of reservation exceeds 20, we will place the other tents in the secondary location, Team Area 2. Spaces will be allocated on a first come, first serve base. Please note that bookings cannot be cancelled.

Team Areas will be accessible from 09.00 Friday 7th of May to Sunday 9th of May 20.00.

The drop-off and the unloading of team equipment can only be on Thursday 6th from 14:00 to 19:00.

Equipment removal can be done on Sunday 9th May from 20.00. Every tent must be cleared out by teams before 22:00.

Medical Cover

A team of doctors and paramedics will be present throughout practice and racing. The team will be based on the track and also have use of a medical room on the right side of the start ramp.

The medical team will be available at all official track events.

Be advised, Covid-19 Hospital restrictions won't allow, at the actual moment, to enter the complex for non-injured people like companions.

Required items athletes has to bring at the hospital:

- 1. Copy of ID/Passport, address, postal code and place of residence.
- Copy of assurance / health care incl. phone number Rider & Team Manager Seating

Seating

The team managers and riders have access to the seating area to watch the race. There is no reserved sitting within the area. This will be accessed using an accreditation or wristband. There will also be an area for Team Managers trackside on the start straight.

Seating and team manager area must follow the Covid-19 restrictions that are explained later in this guide.

Water

We recommend to drink tap water or bottled water.

Food

With Covid-19 restrictions we're not allowed to provide food to teams and staff, however all services of delivery and takeaway from restaurants are available even on site.

Video analysis

A part of the team manager standing area will be reserved for video analysis. Entrance via the BMX Track. Entry passes will be given at the riders confirmation.

NOTE: Any filming of the riders in practice or racing, can solely be used for Team purposes. Teams and riders are not to publish in part or full, any filming of the riders at the track via internet, social media or other means.



Media

All media planning to attend the event must be accredited in order to gain access to the venue. To apply for a press accreditation for the Round 1 and 2 of the UCI BMX Supercross World Cup in Verona you are obliged to send an e-mail to fantonispiazzi@yahoo.it requesting the registration.



Restrictions, Rules, Requirements

Corona virus pandemic has affected everyone and a lot of changes are required in order to follow the safety protocols needed to hold a race.

We are aware that these new measures might somehow seem annoying but for the safety of everyone and to be able to host this event we need everyone to follow the rules. We highly recommend to reduce the risks of infection to the minimum. Depending on the specific situations, eventual positive tests might place the race at risk of being cancelled. We thank you in advance for following these protocols. We highly recommend to read the entire COVID-19 RACE PROTOCOL.

Basic safety measures

Basic safety measures are required such as masks kept on mouth and nose all the time, keeping the safety distance of at least 1m all the time, temperature check entering the track everyday, bringing the self declaration at the first day of practice.

Stand - seating area

Seating on the stands is permitted maintaining a distance of 2 free seats between each person.

Travel

Sport events are possible in our country with specific requirements needed to travel to Italy. Traveling for sport events is one of the cases that allow athletes and all the staff members to avoid any kind of guarantine.

Actual Covid restrictions doesn't allow us to have any spectators on the stands, however, we hope things can change by the approaching of the race.

The track will be divided in three zones (see the following map):

- Green zone the track only riders can stay without protection mask.
- Yellow zone Team Area riders, all Team Managers and Assistants with mask all the time. Only riders can stay without mask only during warm ups. In this area Team managers are responsible to make sure the athletes keep the safety distances (1,5m).
- White zone normally spectators zone Wearing the mask is mandatory all the time. To sit on the stands is mandatory to keep two seat empty in between each spectator.

Bubbles

Each country will have a specific bubble in the team area separated by the other with safety distances, it's the staff duty to keep the bubble safe.

Accomodation

We offer a list of hotels which follow the UCI guideline in Covid-19 spread prevention and can provide discounted prices.

In order to get the discount, rooms reservation must be sent directly to the hotel announcing the participation to the event.







Athletes Registration Requirements

During the riders confirmation on Thursday 6th from 17.30 until 19.30, an official document of PCR test with negative result is required for each athlete and team staff member. Test has to be done within 72h before the Riders Confirmation.



Covid-19 Testing

In order to keep the highest level of safety for every member of the event, a PCR test or Antigenic test with negative result is required to be allowed into the track complex.

Test validity lasts (to get into the track complex) 72h, a team of our staff will be dedicated to keep the check list of all tests.

There will be a testing centre at the entrance, on Friday 7th May, Saturday 8th May and Sunday 9th May with Antigenic tests provided at minimum cost of 25 Euros without certificate and 30 Euros with certificate. Results will be given in 10/15 minutes.

Any other Antigenic test needed could be done in almost any Pharmacy.

Farmacia Castelvecchio is close to the track and provide tests.

PCR Tests prior to departure

PCR tests can be required to travel back to other countries and they can be performed in each of the clinics listed in this link

We recommend to book your PCR test via email, in order to have it at the right time needed. Usually clinics give the results in maximum 24 hours. However, we recommend to ask the clinic the delivery time of results.



Spectators (if permitted)

A maximum of 250 spectators might be allowed to watch the races.

Spectators are to be considered as another isolate bubble and won't be allowed to get in contact with the other two bubbles (riders/teams and media/organization).

The track will be divided in three zones (see the map on the previous page):

- Green zone the track only riders can stay without protection mask.
- Yellow zone Team Area riders, all Team Managers and Assistants with mask all the time. Only
 riders can stay without mask only during warm ups. In this area Team managers are responsible to
 make sure the athletes keep the safety distances (1.5m).
- White zone normally spectators zone Wearing the mask is mandatory all the time. To sit on the stands is mandatory to keep two seat empty in between each spectator.

Known as "The city of Romeo and Juliet", Verona is among the top 10 most visited Italian cities.


Located at only 30km from Lake Garda, Mount Baldo range and Lessinia Natural Park, Verona is the perfect location for an active and cultural holiday.


