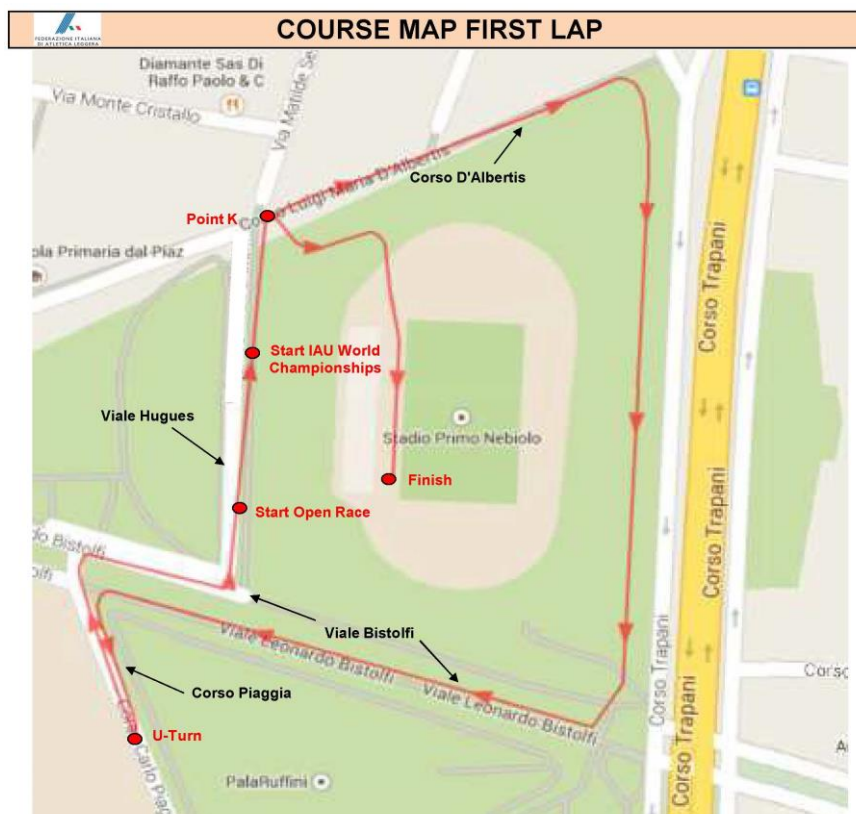


Open race There will be an open race, limited to 180 runners.

Albania (**), F.Y.R. of Macedonia (**), Serbia (**),

(*) For citizens of the Taiwan visa exemption applies only to holders of passports including the number of identity card

(**) For citizens of the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Serbia, the visa exemption applies only to holders of biometric passports.

The citizens of Serbia who are holders of passports issued by the Serbian Coordination Directorate (in Serbian: Koordinaciona uprava) are covered by the exemption from the visa requirement.

The citizens of **Switzerland** are exempted from the visa in any case.

7. TRANSPORTATION PLAN TO THE ATHLETES VILLAGE (AV)



The **LOC** will provide to all delegations the followings transports:

Arrival day:

Delegations arriving at TURIN airport will be transported to their hotel by shuttle which will be ready to pick you maximizing the use of capacity.



Technical Meeting and Open Ceremony day:

From the hotel to the Primo Nebiolo Stadium and back

Competition day:

From the hotel to competition place and back



Departure day:

The LOC will provide transportation to the Turin airport for all the delegations.

8. ACCOMMODATION

The Organizing Committee will offer:

- a **Lunch, Dinner, Packet Lunch**, free of charge (*),
- for **maximum 3 male and 3 female athletes** per delegation
 - o for a maximum of **3 nights** for delegations who should fly maximum 4 h
 - o for a maximum of **4 nights** for delegations who should fly maximum <9 h
 - o for a maximum of **5 nights** for delegations who should fly minimum 9 h

(*) when a delegation consists of only 1 athlete, then he/she will be put together in a room with another athlete of the same gender who came alone. When these athletes doesn't want to be accommodated like this, they must inform the LOC about this on the FEF. At that occasion the LOC is allowed to ask this athlete to pay the difference between single and double room.

The accommodation (**FULL BOARD**) will be charged following this rates:
