Registration is possible via the LOC website. The Open Race will start +/- 200 meters behind the MIAUC-race.




















DESCRIPTION FIRST LAP

Any foreign visitor wishing to visit Italy should have a valid passport or an EU ID-Card .

IAU Members which **DO NOT NEED A VISA** prior to departure:

All EU countries, Andorra, Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Brunei, Canada, South Korea, Costa Rica, Croatia, Japan, Hong Kong, Israel, Mexico, Monaco, New Zealand, United States, Uruguay, Bulgaria,

Taiwan (*), Albania (**), F.Y.R. of Macedonia (**), Serbia (**),

- (*) For citizens of the Taiwan visa exemption applies only to holders of passports including the number of identity card
- (**) For citizens of the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Serbia, the visa exemption applies only to holders of biometric passports.

The citizens of Serbia who are holders of passports issued by the Serbian Coordination Directorate (in Serbian: Koordinaciona upreva) are covered by the exemption from the visa requirement.

The citizens of **Switzerland** are exempted from the visa in any case.

The Organizing Committee will offer:

- o for a maximum of **3 nights** for delegations who should fly maximum 4 h
- o for a maximum of **4 nights** for delegations who should fly maximum < 9 h
- o for a maximum of **5 nights** for delegations who should fly minimum 9 h



(*) when a delegation consists of only 1 athlete, then he/she will be put together in a room with another athlete of the same gender who came alone. When these athletes doesn't want to be accommodated like this, they must inform the LOC about this on the FEF. At that occasion the LOC is allowed to ask this athlete to pay the difference between single and double room.
