

# Poncho triangulaire

Stitches used: garter stitch = knit all stitches  
knit front/back = knit into front of the stitch then into the back of the  
stitch without dropping the stitch from the needle

Very easy level

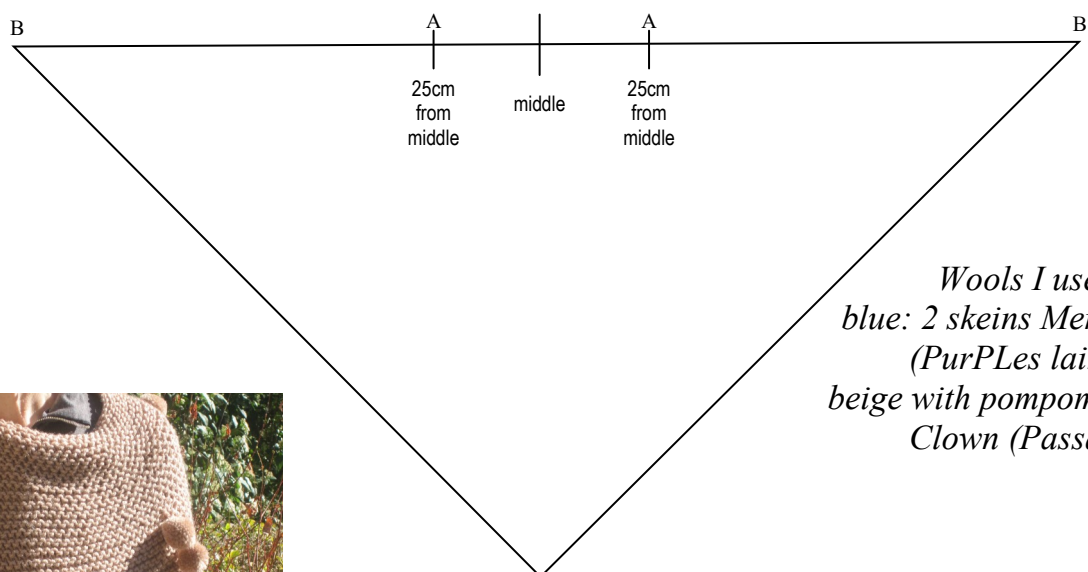
It can be knitted with any thickness of yarn because you only need to  
measure, not to count stitches.



Cast on 4 stitches

Row 1: knit all stitches

Following rows Knit into front and back of stitch, then knit remaining  
stitches. When the shawl measures 1.75 metres,  
cast off all stitches very loosely.



*Wools I used*  
*blue: 2 skeins Merinos DK*  
*(PurPLes laines)*  
*beige with pompoms: 3 balls*  
*Clown (Passard)*



For the blue poncho I made an opening 7 stitches from the edge.  
When you have 19 stitches in your row, knit all rows the same:  
knit 7, knit 2 together, make 1, knit to end of row.
