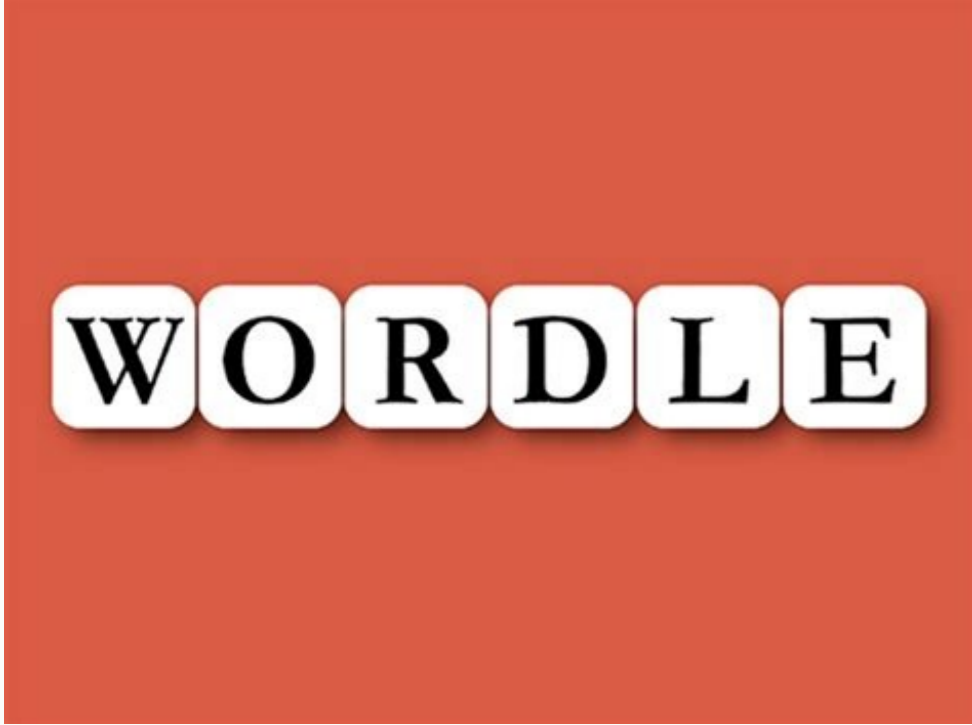

See you tomorrow. Meaty slashed that number down to just two. Still, it's one of those answers where a number of possible letters can fit when your three core ones have turned green. I began with my new favorite start word: ORATE. Each time you guess, you're told which of your chosen letters are in the target word, and whether they are in the right place. That reduced the number of possible answers to just nine*. (Image credit: Alan Martin) Immediately, I thought it was going to be either SWIPE or SNIPE. But, because the three remaining letters are all pretty rare, all this did was confirm the position of 'E'. That's when you're living the dream, which I suppose is how I think about my job except for when I get knocked down with a bade case of writer's block (or just pure laziness, which is also a thing we writersly types have to sometimes reckon with). Vowels obviously need consideration too: not all Wordle answers will contain more than one, but plenty do, and some even have three. As it turns green, I remember the bittersweet smiles my new friend and I exchanged when the train finally pulled into the station. Indeed, WordleBot says that with these two letters confirmed, just 12 possible answers were left over*. Not many of WordleBot's recommended start words beat that, though plenty match it. Comments are moderated for civility. Having a technical issue? Thanks! Today's Wordle answer is one of those words where a number of possibilities are left when your core letters are in place. So I was left somewhat surprised when typing in the 'P' yellow, as I hadn't considered any of the three options beginning 'SP'. Playing SNIPE actually ruled out one of those, as it could no longer be SPINE. And just as picking idly at my cuticles began to threaten my sanity, my seat neighbor tapped me on the shoulder. "This might be silly," she said, holding out a pen and paper, "but do you want to play 'Hangman'?" Reader, I did. But if you're still struggling with Wordle, check out how Tom's Guide's Wordle experts have honed their strategy after playing every Wordle so far and losing only once. 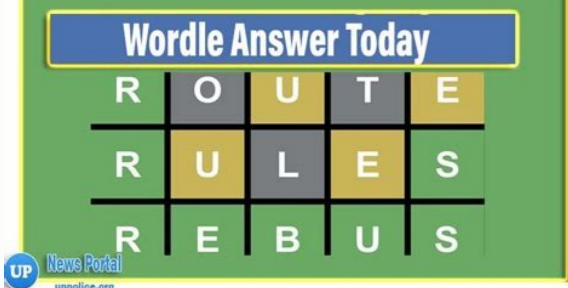
-1 point for losing to me You can either keep a running tally of your score if that's your jam or just play day-to-day if you prefer. A good Wordle start word should have used a couple, but if they don't feature you might well want to try another one or two on your next go. (You can read my thoughts on the 5 things Wordle needs to improve if it's to keep us playing for its third year.) However, it only grew in popularity towards the end of the year, then went viral in January as the world woke up to its charms. And if it's not in the word at all, it turns gray. There's just one puzzle a day, and everyone completes the same one. We were free to go. I rate this Wordle two out of five stars because magma is also an upsetting metaphor for our times (burning garbage), albeit in a more geologically beneficial way. Today's word is MAGMA, a noun. I have not a correct letter in sight, and growing qualms about my ability to guess any. I and the dozen other passengers in my car learned there was a track fire ahead due to some debris — burning garbage, as ever a metaphor for our times — and that we would be held indefinitely. So we waited; the car grew silent, dim, and un-air-conditioned. Some people think that Wordle has got harder since the NYT takeover, but it really hasn't. Wordle is a simple game in which your challenge is to guess a five-letter word in six attempts. According to the New York Times' WordleBot, the average player completes Wordle #794 in 4.0 moves in easy mode, or 3.9 if playing by hard rules. The word "beach" gradually evolved to refer more specifically to the sandy, shore-like areas along the coast where land meets the sea. Spare left me with two correct letters (one in green, one in yellow) and only 20 words remaining. Today, I did pretty good and got pretty lucky. I typed it in and celebrated a four-turn win. Hopefully you did it in three or under today, Wordlers. Over time, as languages evolve and cultures interact, words tend to change in form and meaning. Whatever you want to call it. Today's Wordle is moderately challenging because of its repeated letters. The letter pattern is distinct enough that the answer can usually be found using elimination strategies within six guesses, but the word has duplicated letters, making it tricky. I'm happy with a four-turn win, though really my third guess was a misstep and I should have spent a bit longer thinking about it. But I'm getting ahead of myself. Wordle officially launched in October 2021, but actually started in June of that year and celebrated its first birthday on June 19, 2022.
